The Southwestern Diocese Sunday School & HYM Congress is committed to investing in the lives of our young people. It is our goal to encourage our young people in every area... spiritual growth, community involvement, and excellence in education.

Middle School or Junior High School

I. Criteria for Submission

This recognition is provided yearly to a young person of our diocese that is currently enrolled in a middle or junior high school. Recipient of this award may renew until he/she is named Jr. Youth of the Year on the Diocese level.

In order to apply for this award, applicant must meet all of the following requirements at the time of submission:

- Must be an active member of a church within in the SW Diocese;
- Must be an active member of the local Sunday School and/or HYM;
- Must have completed 1 year of a middle school or junior high school;
 - (Applicant will be judged on the basis of their school's set-up. Example: If your school is named AMC Middle School or AMC Jr. High School.)
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above;
- ALL sections of this application & supporting documents must be typed, with the exception of original signatures

II. Recognition & Judging Criteria for Award

A. DOCUMENTATION: Applicant must present the following:

(Letters of Recommendations must be current year and typed)

- Copy of Final Report Card (last ending school year) (5 pts)
- Letter of Recommendation from Sunday School Superintendent (5pts)
- Letter of Recommendation from H.Y.M. Group Leader (5 pts) **A recommendation from an auxiliary head may be submitted **only** if an HYM is not established**
- Letter of Recommendation from Pastor (5 pts)
- Letter of Recommendation from a teacher or school official (*Principal or Guidance Counselor*) (5 pts)
 all letters must contain an original signature

TOTAL OF 25 POINTS

B. ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Applicants must list their accomplishments, i.e., activity, participation, offices held and/or awards in the following areas (during school middle/junior high school years only): **Separate categories** with dividers. Provide a captioned artifact for each accomplishment.

- Church involvement: 2 pts per activity and artifact (10 pts max)
- Honors and Awards: 1 pt. per activity and artifact (5 pts max)
- Extracurricular Activities: 1 pt. per activity and artifact (5 pts max)
- Community Involvement: (1 pt. per activity and artifact 5 pts)

TOTAL OF 25 POINTS maximum

C. ESSAY:

- Content (10 pts) essay is related to topic, has well organized thoughts, and provides compelling support to the thesis
- Shall <u>not</u> be less than 100 words but not exceed 150 words (5 pts)
- Grammar/Punctuation (5 pts) 1 pt. deducted per error
- Double Spaced/Typed (5 pts) 12 pt font, Times New Roman, 1' margin, header containing name and page number

D. INTERVIEW: Each applicant must be interviewed in person by the local church committee, District Youth of the Year Committee, and Diocese Youth of the Year Committee. See rubric
