Sis. Moore often spoke with her children and grandchildren about attending Bethel Church of Christ Holiness (USA) knowing the power of the local church. Sis. Moore discussed being baptized in the creek and shared memories of being one of the first young ladies at Bethel to have a traditional wedding. Although she wanted to go to college after graduating from Washington Parish High School in 1957, her family couldn't afford it.

Sharing in her legacy within the Southwestern Diocese, her son, Dr. Leonard Moore started a college ministry on the campus of LSU that "is still paying dividends." Dr. Moore states, many of the black students who were at LSU during that time talk about how impactful it was. Again, showing the power of the local church. In her memory, the Moore Family will grant five (5) \$700 scholarships to college students within the Southwestern Diocese.

The spirit of this scholarship centers on the local church. To be eligible for this scholarship you must:

- Profess Jesus Christ to be your Savior
- Be active in a local church within the Southwestern Diocese
- Be entering or presently enrolled at a four-year college or university
- Must show evidence of financial need
- Have a 2.5 GPA

- A video explaining the follow:
 - how your local church has impacted you;
 - how you impact your local church;
