

# 2022 Peggy Sue Burton Moore Memorial Scholarship

## About

Sister Peggy Sue Moore often spoke with her children and grandchildren about attending Bethel Church of Christ Holiness (USA) in Franklinton, Louisiana knowing the power of the local church. Sister Moore discussed being baptized in the creek and shared memories of being one of the first young ladies at Bethel COCHUSA to have a traditional wedding. Although Sister Moore wanted to go to college after graduating from Washington Parish High School in 1957, her family could not afford it.

Sharing in her legacy within the Southwestern Diocese, her son, Dr. Leonard Moore started a college ministry on the campus of Louisiana State University (LSU) that "is still paying dividends." Dr. Moore states, "many of the black students who were at LSU during that time talk about how impactful it was." Again, showing the power of the local church. In her memory, Dr. & Mrs. Leonard Moore selected to allow the Southwestern Diocese Sunday School & HYM Congress to grant three (3) \$1,000 scholarships to college students in their mother's memory.

The spirit of this scholarship centers on the local church. To be eligible for this scholarship, one must:

- Profess Jesus Christ to be your Savior
- Be active in a local church within the Southwestern Diocese
- Be entering or presently enrolled at a four-year college or university
- Must show evidence of financial need
- Must show proof of a 2.0 or greater GPA

Applications will be evaluated by the district scholarship coordinators. The applicant with the highest score will represent the district and be sent to the Southwestern Diocese Vice-President to be evaluated. 3 applicants will be chosen for the scholarship.

- A letter of recommendation from either the HYM Group Leader or Sunday School Superintendent
  - Letter may be signed electronically;

  - how your local church has impacted you;
  - how you impact your local church;
  - and your financial need.
